The magnificent baronial castle of Pittormie is Scotland's most exclusive private estate that is located in St. Andrews. Only Getaway2Give trip winners and Eden Club members have access to this destination. The Castle has become the fulcrum of every guests visit to Scotland, with staff organizing golf, accommodation, dining, transfers, alternative activities and sightseeing excursions for non-playing partners. Pittormie lies in the heart of north east Fife amongst some of the most glorious and unspoiled fertile farmland of Scotland's most productive counties. It is within 4 miles of the beautiful East Neuk of Fife coastline with its sandy beaches, birdlife and fine flora. Formerly the home of the first Duke of Fife, having been given to Ludovic of Lennox by King James VI in 1596, the Castle was lovingly restored by The Eden Club in 2005 under the guidance of Historic Scotland. Available experiences on site include archery, falconry, private whiskey tours, horse riding, fishing, mountain biking, and beach carting.

Golf Courses Near Pittormie Castle

Kingsbarns Golf Links – Par 72, 6652 yards, \$223pp – 25 minutes drive

While its golf origins date back to 1793, the multi-award-winning Kingsbarns Golf Links opened in the summer of 2000. The course's reputation is based on a combination of playability, dramatic seaside location and classic links turf. Designed by Kyle Phillips in collaboration with Mark Parsinen, every hole on this course offers inspiring views of the North Sea. Kingsbarns has become a favorite destination for first-time and returning international golf visitors to St Andrews.

Carnoustie – Par 72, 6941 yards, \$209pp – 35 minutes drive

Carnoustie is considered by many to be the toughest of all the Open links courses. Walter Hagen described it as 'A great big shaggy monster' going on to praise it as the greatest golf course in the British Isles and one of the top three in the world. Historians believe the game has been played here since the early 16th century and while the course is not the prettiest you will ever play (you rarely catch a glimpse of the sea) it is a delightfully brutal monster that is an absolute must-play course.

The Torrance – Par 72, 7037 yards, \$98pp - 10 minutes drive

Names after golf course architect and Ryder Cup winning Captain Sam Torrance this new links course immediately tests your accuracy with classic links riveted bunkers and the occasional meandering stream. Home to Open qualifying for the 2010 Open, The Torrance is a test for tour professionals and amateur golfers. From beautiful sea views to intricate USGA greens, the course having been reengineered in 2008 is now one of Fifes' finest.

The New Course – Par 71, 6625 yards, \$91pp - Buggy hire available – 5 minutes drive

Almost 500 years passed before St Andrews built a second course. Built in 1840 'The New Course' was designed by 'Old' Tom Morris – winner of four Open Championships – and David Honeyman; who developed the layout based on the traditional out and back routing model. Among its most famous features are its shared fairways and a double green at the 3rd and 15th holes. The 'New' is a tough test of golf with similar characteristics to the 'Old', offering a classic links challenge that uses the natural features of the land and elements to protect itself.

Notes

- A stay can be reserved, based on availability, anytime during the year with the exception of Christmas and New Year's.
