Charleston Klein is 9 years old and is like many other boys his age. He enjoys playing with his brothers and friends, spending time with grandparents, running outside, even snowskiing and water skiing. But Charles also has juvenile Batten disease.

Juvenile Batten disease affects otherwise healthy children and causes blindness, motor and cognitive loss, uncontrollable seizures and is always fatal by late teens or twenties.

Bind Up Batten fund was created by Charleston's parents Mike and Jo (Tippenhauer) Klein 2018. Jo and Mike are originally from Toledo and have family in the community. In just a year the fund has raised nearly \$100,000 for research.

Bind up Batten has joined Beyond Batten Disease Foundation and other families around the world to eradicate juvenile Batten disease.
